

GIFT AID

The information and form below apply only to UK taxpayers.

Under the Government's Gift Aid Scheme the Society can reclaim from the Inland Revenue the basic rate income tax you have paid in respect of your donation, if you complete the following declaration and return it to us.

Please read these notes carefully before completing the declaration.

1. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax (including tax you may pay on your savings) at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your payments in the tax year.
2. If in future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax at the level defined in note 1, you must cancel your declaration.
3. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief on your Tax Return.
4. Please notify us if you change your name or address.
5. You must keep a record of this declaration and the payments under it, and report them on your Tax Return.
